

Montaire Icelandic Horse Show COVID-19 Policy

At Montaire and Equitaire, your health and safety are our top priority. As part of this commitment, we've taken proactive steps and implemented new guidelines and policies to help support a safe experience. Everyone in attendance, including vendors, participants, spectators and staff, are expected to comply with our health and safety requirements, including:

Vaccinations

Everyone 12 years old and older is required to be fully vaccinated before entering the show grounds. There are no exceptions to this rule.

Face coverings

Everyone 2 to 12 years old will be required to wear a mask except when riding or eating. Face covering is optional for all persons 12 years old and older while attending the Montaire Icelandic Horse Show. Masks can be removed when riding a horse and when eating.

All face coverings must, at a minimum:

Fit properly and snugly, **fully covering your nose and mouth, and secure under your chin**

Not Permitted:

- Face coverings with exhalation valves
- Face coverings, including bandanas, that are unable to be secured under your chin
- Neck Gaiters
- Mesh materials
- Face coverings which contain holes or are significantly damaged
- Costume masks

Temperature Screening

Everyone attending Montaire Icelandic Horse Show will be required to undergo a temperature screening at check-in. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 degrees (F) will not be permitted entry to Montaire and Equitaire.

Increased Sanitization and Hygiene

Montaire and Equitaire will provide sanitation stations throughout the facilities. It is the responsibility of everyone to maintain personal hygiene, including washing your hands frequently for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm water.

Physical Distancing

We have adjusted our layout and implemented guidelines and requirements to promote physical distancing. Please help us maintain the well-being of everyone at Montaire and Equitaire by maintaining 6 ft. (2 meters) between you and others when possible.

Follow All Signage and Direction from Staff

Operational adjustments may occur throughout the show to ensure the health and safety of all attendees. Please adhere to all signage and direction from all staff.

Greet Without Shaking Hands

Please observe social distancing guidelines when greeting others, avoid handshakes and hugs.

- That you will abide by all Montaire Icelandic Horse Show health-and-safety requirements.
- That you are not currently experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19, as identified at [CDC.gov](#), including, but not limited to:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- That prior to attending Montaire Icelandic Horse Show you have not been in contact with someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 symptoms without completing a 14-day quarantine; and
- That you are not under any self-quarantine orders.

Please do not enter Montaire or Equitaire if you cannot confirm all the above criteria. If at any point during your time at Montaire and Equitaire you do not meet all the above criteria, you will be required to isolate and may be relocated or asked to leave at the sole discretion of event management.

Please note: The guidelines in this document are based on information currently available regarding the behavior and characteristics of the COVID-19 virus, public health information and local or state guidelines with respect to large gatherings. As more clarity with respect to these variables emerges, it is expected that these guidelines may need to be adjusted accordingly
